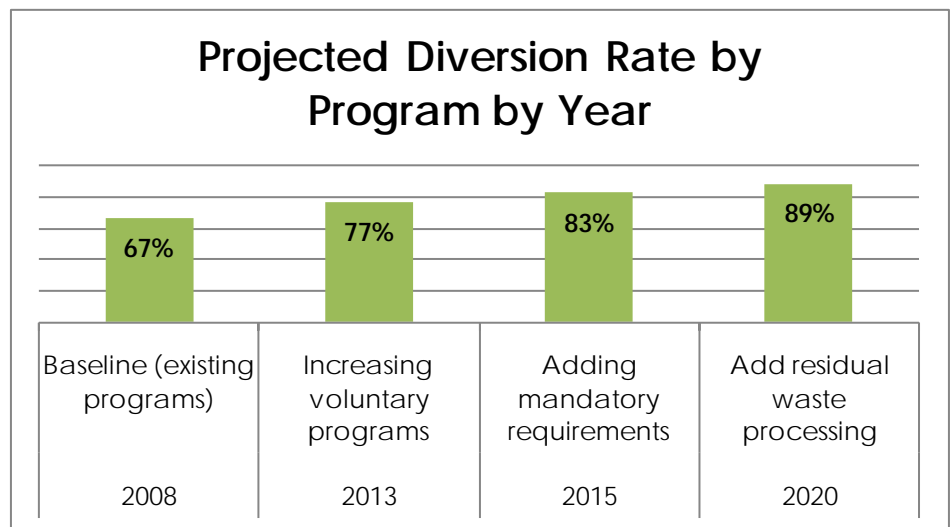


Community Workshop August 25th

Alameda has pledged to reduce community-wide greenhouse gas emissions by 25 percent below 2005 levels by 2020. **Zero waste initiatives** offer the most effective greenhouse gas reduction potential.

Over the past year, stakeholders in Alameda have contributed to the development of the **Alameda Zero Waste Implementation Plan**.

The **Alameda Zero Waste Implementation Plan** identifies a 10-year program which is expected to increase the City's diversion rate to 89 percent and reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 44,424 metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent by 2020.



The **City of Alameda** has partnered with the **Community Action for a Sustainable Alameda** to sponsor a community workshop to review the findings of the **Zero Waste Implementation Plan**.
